



## City Council Meeting Summary for September 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2020

**Ordinance 16-20:** Adoption of the General Fund Budget: The budget for Q2-Q4 passed.

**Ordinance 17-20:** Adoption of the Water Budget: The budget for the Water Utility passed.

**Ordinance 18-20:** Adoption of the Sewer Budget: The budget for the Sewer Utility passed.

**Ordinance 19-20:** Eliminating Dog Tag Fees: This ordinance passed, and dog tags will now be provided free of charge. The ordinance was also amended to allow dog tags to be valid for up to three years to run with the length of the rabies vaccination.

**Ordinance 20-20:** Eliminating the Fee for Residential Golf Cart Permits: Golf cart permits for residents and owners are free starting January 1. Rental golf cart permits still require payment, and golf carts must still be registered within the City.

**Ordinance 21-20:** Raising the Base Fee for Short Term Rentals: The starting rate for a short-term rental business license is now \$245 dollars instead of \$145 dollars.

**Resolution 36-20:** A Resolution to Purchase Fire Trucks: This resolution was postponed for further information. It will be back at City Council at the October meeting.

**Resolution 37-20:** A Resolution to Join a Lawsuit Against Online Rental Companies: This resolution was approved. The City will be joining other municipalities in pursuing business license fees from companies like Air BnB.
